Maintenance Projects

In the Third quarter of FY2011, the City of Manitou Springs has conducted the following activity related to PPRTA funding:

2010 Maintenance Projects

In July 2011, the City consulted with 4 contractors for a Chipseal program which covered a number of paved and non paved streets. Bids were received from the 4 contractors. The City decided to award the contract to EWS Steel Aggregate as they were the lowest price per square feet with the understanding that the actual square footage would be invoiced accordingly. Their bid was submitted to the PPRTA Board in July and was approved under those conditions. EWS Steel Aggregate finished the project for a total of \$199,473.00.

The scope of work for EWS includes the following streets:

- 2" overlay: Agate Ave, Crystal cul-de-sac 1, 2 & 3, Elk Path, Fairmont Ave., Garnet Ave., Jade Ave., Manitou Ter., Mica Ave., Peak View Blvd., Puma Path, Seneca Rd., Tulsa Rd., Plainview Place, and Spur Rd.
- 3" Milling Overlay: Alpine Trail, Burn Rd., Geneva Trail, Lucerne Trail, and Trestle Trail.
- ½" Chip Seal and Fog Seal: Bond St., Chelton rd., Spur Rd., Short Rd., Via Chula Vista, South Side Rd., Duncan Ave., Chipeta Rd., Tio Rd., Uinta Rd., Terrace Place, and Winona Rd.

**Capital Projects**

This quarter, the City of Manitou Springs has spent an additional \$5,956.00 towards final design of Manitou Streetscape Phase 5B/PPRTA Phase 3. This is the final phase of this federally funded downtown revitalization project.
