PPRTA Third Quarter Progress Report 2019

Please find the following progress summary from June 2019 to date.

Town staff continued coordinating with PPRTA and El Paso County regarding the Belvidere Avenue Improvement Project. In the first week of June, Kiewitt paved Belvidere Avenue, and also replaced the collapsed culvert at Belvidere and Iona Avenue. After the work was completed, citizens noticed that with rain, the pavement began to be undercut and other curbing and guttering/swales (shouldering) concerns were noted. After inspection by the Project Engineer it was determined that some additional work needed to be done. In October 2019, Belvidere was patched by Kiewitt, and upon evaluation of the work the Project Engineer with El Paso County recommended we leave the project open and roll it into 2020, because snow coverage made it impossible to evaluate the touch up patchwork. The Town continues to work in conjunction with both El Paso County and Kiewitt toward completion of the initial project and successful solutions for our residents.

With respect to the Town's third quarter maintenance allocation, road maintenance plans will continue to be laid out and implemented in the 4th Quarter as the Town has now hired (as of October 4th) one of the two full time Public Works staff we hope to have in place.
