Project Description: The PPRTA II ballot identified an “A List” project to widen Black Forest Road to a four-lane principal arterial cross-section from Woodmen Road to Research Parkway, including a new bridge over Cottonwood Creek. The existing and proposed developments in the City and the County require more capacity on Black Forest Road than the current two-lane section provides.

The City advertised the project for construction bids on December 29, 2021. Bids were opened on January 27, 2022 and 4 bids were received. Bids received are listed below.
